The following change to fees related to trash bags collected was decided by the Laporte Township Supervisors: Small bags (33 gallon maximum size and up to 20 pounds weight) will be charged \$2.50/bag. Large bags (Over 33/gallon size or over 20 pounds weight) will be charged \$4.50/bag. \$0.25/bag from any size bag will continue to be allocated to the Laporte Volunteer Fire Company.
